The Clavey: A River Running Wild


The Turlock City Arts Commission is pleased to present *The Clavey: A River Running Wild*, a new exhibition at the City Gallery, located inside Turlock City Hall. The exhibition will be on view through June 25, 2008. With a combination of beautiful images with messages about environmental stewardship, this exhibition should generate quite a lot of interest.

The show features a series of color photographs, commissioned by the Tuolumne River Trust which was created by environmental photographer Ron Pickup. A Tuolumne County native, Ron has photographed the Sierra Nevada for over 35 years. His fine art photography has been exhibited at the Smithsonian Institution and California Academy of Sciences, and was recently featured at the Great Valley Museum at Modesto Junior College. The exhibition includes 38 images that trace the Clavey River's 47-mile descent from its snow melt origins in the high Sierra to its confluence with the Tuolumne River. Pickup has captured the beauty of the Clavey through the seasons in images ranging from intimate details of wildflowers to awe-inspiring vistas.

In connection with Downtown Turlock's *Art in the Open* street fair on June 21, the Turlock City Arts Commission will be hosting a slide lecture by Galen Weston, Program Associate for the Tuolumne River Trust. Mr. Weston will be discussing work on the Tuolumne Watershed area, the Clavey River Ecosystem project, and the development of the traveling photography exhibition. The slide lecture will take place inside City Hall on Saturday, June 21, at 6:00 p.m. The event is free and open to the public.

- The City Gallery is open Monday - Friday, 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. (excluding major holidays), and 2nd and 4th Tuesday evenings during City Council meetings.
- Admission to the gallery is free.
